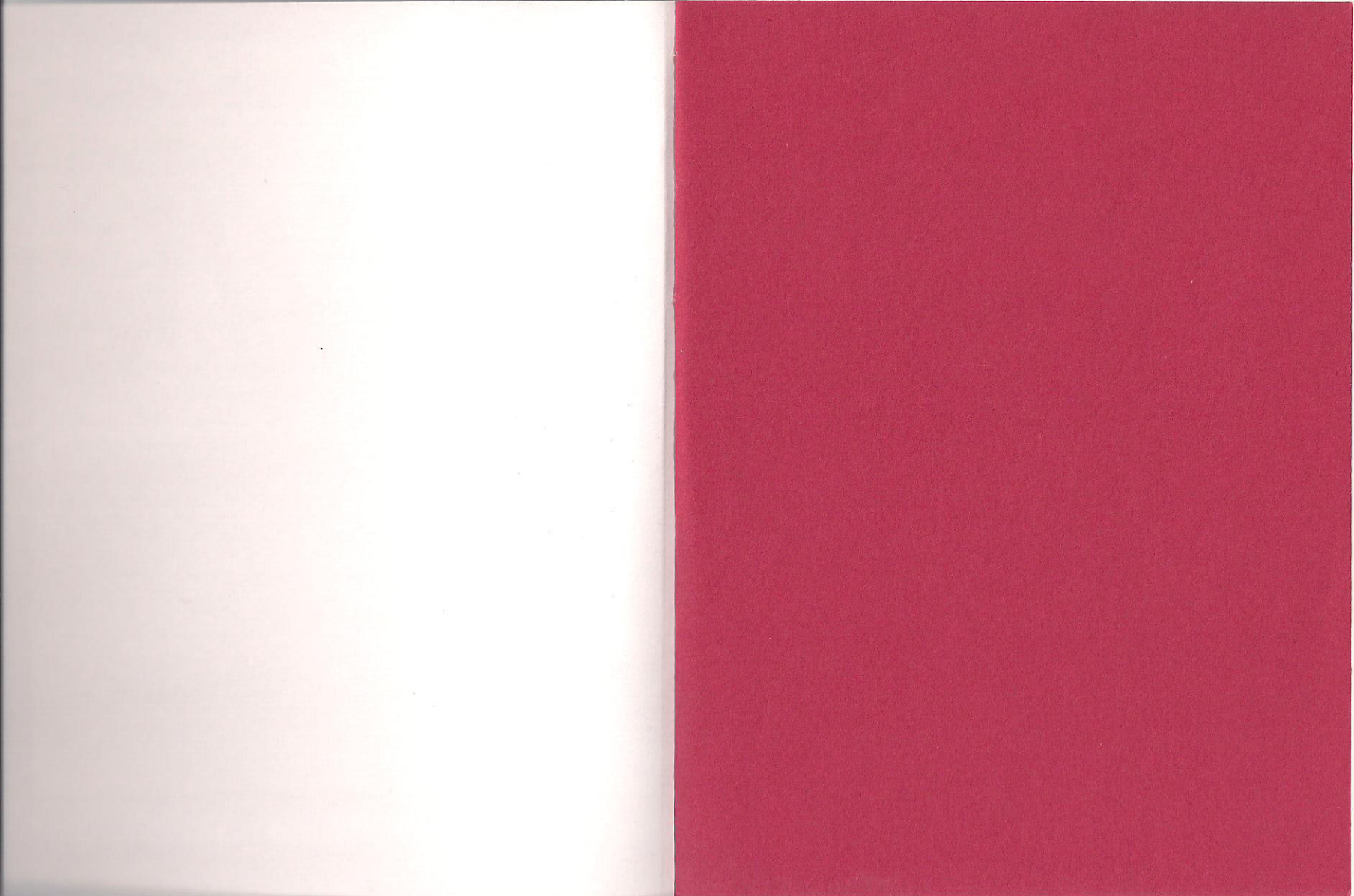

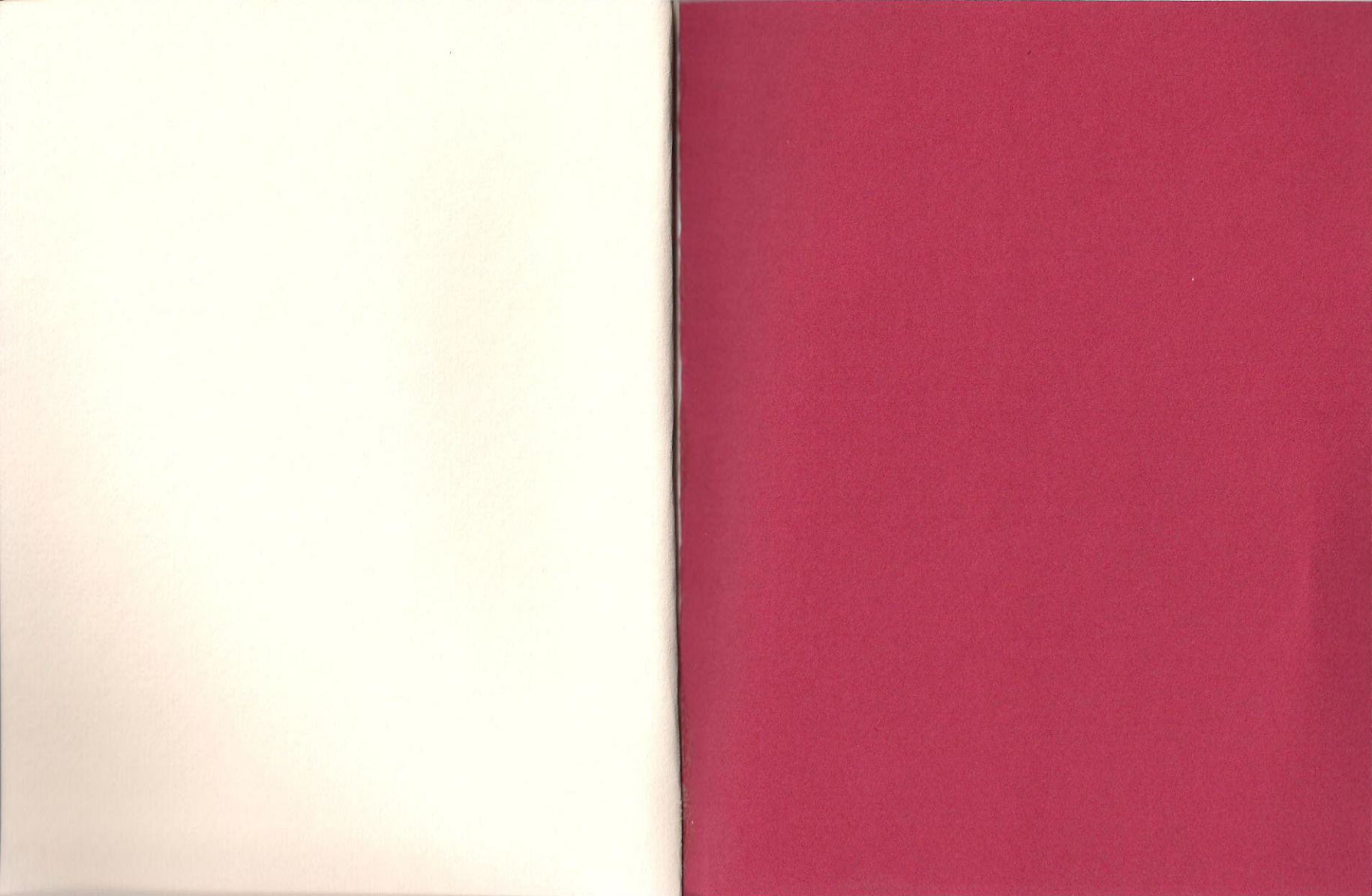

Allen Ginsberg's *HOWL AND OTHER POEMS* was originally published by City Lights Books in the Fall of 1956. Subsequently seized by U.S. customs and the San Francisco police, it was the subject of a long court trial at which it was declared obscene and its publisher and author were fined. Ginsberg adds: "High school in Mexico City, market research, Salori in Harlem, Yucatan and Chiapas 1954, West Coast 3 years. Later Arctic, Carip, Tangier, Venice, Amsterdam, Paris, read at Oxford Harvard Columbia Chicago, quit, wrote *Kaddish* 1959, made tape to learn, blessed & faded, Orient awhile, Carl Solomon to know *HOWL* addressed, ism in multiple Brixton, London, dadaist and post-poet, \$6.95.
